Privacy Policy

At **Derventio Education** we are committed to safeguarding and preserving the privacy of our visitors.

This Privacy Policy explains what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you whilst you visit our site.

We do update this Policy from time to time so please do review this Policy regularly.

Information We Collect

From time to time you will be asked to enter personal information about yourself, this will be name, email address and your telephone number. This is in order to receive services from us such as news articles, email updates and product updates.

In running and maintaining our website we may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information about your use of our site including details of your visits such as pages viewed and the resources that you access. Such information includes traffic data, location data and other communication data
- Information provided voluntarily by you. For example, when you register for information or make a purchase
- Information that you provide when you communicate with us by any means

We do not pass your details on to any third party or other government department.

Use of Cookies

Cookies provide information regarding the computer used by a visitor. We may use cookies where appropriate to gather information about your computer in order to assist us in improving our website.

Cookies are small data files placed on the hard drive of your computer when you visit a website. A “session cookie” expires when you end your session (i.e. close your browser). A “persistent cookie” stores information on your hard drive so when you end your session and return to the same website at a later date, the cookie information is still available

We may gather information about your general internet use by using the cookie. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer and stored on the computer’s hard drive. Such information will not identify you personally. It is statistical data. This statistical data does not identify any personal details whatsoever.

You can adjust the settings on your computer to decline any cookies if you wish. This can easily be done by activating the 'reject cookies' setting on your computer.

Below are all the cookies that we use on our website and their purposes as well as the expiry on the cookies.

collect	Used to send data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behaviour. Tracks the visitor across devices and marketing channels.	2 Years

guest_id	Collects anonymous data related to the user's visits to the website, such as the number of visits, average time spent on the website and which pages have been loaded, with the purpose of personalising and improving the Twitter service.	2 Years
lidc	Used by the social networking service, LinkedIn , for tracking the use of embedded services.	Session
personalization_id	This cookie is set due to Twitter integration and sharing capabilities for the social media.	2 Years
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	Tries to estimate the users' bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos	179 Days
YSC	Registers a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen	Session
Tawkuuid	Third party cookie that remembers you so that we can link chat conversations together to provide a better service.	10 Years

ss	Helps serve live chat functionality	Session

Use of Your Information

We use the information that we collect from you to provide our services to you. In addition to this we may use the information for one or more of the following purposes:

- To provide information to you that you request from us relating to our products or services
- To provide information to you relating to other products that may be of interest to you. Such additional information will only be provided where you have consented to receive such information
- To inform you of any changes to our website, services or goods and products
- If you have previously purchased services from us we may provide to you details of similar services, or other services, that you may be interested in
- Where your consent has been provided in advance we may allow selected third parties to use your data to enable them to provide you with information regarding unrelated goods and services which we believe may interest you. Where such consent has been provided it can be withdrawn by you at any time.

Storing Your Personal Data

Our site is stored on servers hosted in the UK.

In operating our website, it may become necessary to transfer data that we collect from you to locations outside of the European Union for processing and storing. By providing your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We do our up-most to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to make sure that your data is treated and stored securely.

Unfortunately, the sending of information via the internet is not totally secure and on occasion such information can be intercepted. We cannot guarantee the security of data that you choose to send us electronically, sending such information is entirely at your own risk.

Disclosing Your Information

We will not disclose your personal information to any other party other than in accordance with this Privacy Policy and in the circumstances detailed below:

- In the event that we sell any or all of our business to the buyer
- Where we are legally required by law to disclose your personal information
- To further fraud protection and reduce the risk of fraud
- Third Party Links

Legal basis of processing personal information

We process personal data based on your consent for marketing our business and products. If you are a customer then we also do this to perform any obligations we may have under the terms and conditions between us.

Your Rights

Data Breach Policy

In the event that Derventio Education becomes aware of a security breach which they believe has resulted or may result in the unauthorized access, use or disclosure to non-public personal information of End Users, Derventio Education will immediately investigate the matter and notify the affected customers of such breach within 72 hours of the breach being discovered.

The following procedure is in place for dealing with Data Breaches,

Upon discovery of a data breach the employee will notify their manager of the circumstances of the breach - this will be date, location and circumstances of the breach.

Following on from the breach discovery, Derventio Education will perform an analysis to determine the following:

1. What personal information is affected by the breach.
2. What potential harm could occur as the result of the breach and whether it is significant or not.
3. What number of individuals are affected who are at real risk of significant harm as a result of the incident.
4. What steps need to be undertaken to restore the integrity of the data to stop future breaches occurring.

Access to Information

In accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998, and from May 25th 2018 the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you have the right to access any information that we hold relating to you. Please note that we reserve the right to charge a fee of £10 to cover costs incurred by us in providing you with the information.
