## Has SchooliP improved your school's processes?

"SchooliP has streamlined our teacher KPI and school development processes by bringing everything into one place.

For teacher KPIs, we now use a standardised framework aligned with the School Development Plan, which ensures individual objectives cascade directly from whole-school priorities. Progress is tracked live on dashboards, with evidence from lesson observations, learning walks and work scrutiny attached to objectives, making reviews more focused and transparent. Midcycle and end-of-year reviews are structured through built-in templates, with automated reminders reducing the admin load. CPD is also linked to individual KPIs, so professional development activities are tied to measurable impact rather than box-ticking.

On the school development side, the SDP, SEF evidence and monitoring events are integrated, giving us clear audit-ready reports for leadership and governors. This means off-track priorities are flagged early, allowing us to redirect support quickly.

Overall, SchooliP has reduced time spent on fragmented spreadsheets and paperwork, improved accountability by making ownership and timelines clear, and strengthened professional conversations by keeping the focus on impact and next steps rather than administration."







## Does SchooliP provide your school with data?

"SchooliP has centralised the way we collect, store and present school data, which has been especially valuable for accreditation and inspection frameworks.

Evidence from lesson observations, CPD impact reviews, learner outcomes and quality assurance activities are all captured within the platform and linked directly to our School Development Plan. This means we can generate clear, audit-ready reports for frameworks such as Cognia and CIS, showing not just compliance but the ongoing cycle of improvement.

The ability to attach documents, notes and quantitative measures to objectives creates a single evidence base that leadership, governors and accreditation teams can access quickly. By consolidating everything into one system, we have reduced duplication across spreadsheets and documents, while strengthening the reliability and consistency of the data we present externally.

Ultimately, this has made our school improvement processes more transparent and defensible, with a clear line of sight from classroom practice to whole-school outcomes."








## Has SchooliP reduced your teachers' workloads?
